The Pagett and Betton Funds: Guidance for Applicants

The **Pagett Fund** was set up by the Society using the bequest made by John Pagett to enable the Trustees to make grants to individuals or organisations who are seeking funding to pursue activities which fall into at least one of the following categories:

1. The advancement of the education of the public in archaeological and historical investigation in Shropshire.
2. The preservation of antiquities in the county of Shropshire.

The **Betton Fund** was originally established with a view to supporting the publication of Parish Registers in Shropshire and the adjoining counties. The terms of the Fund have now been amended to support the same objectives as the **Pagett Fund**. The Society welcomes applications relating to any aspect of the archaeology and history of the county.

Applicants should be advised that grants will typically be up to a maximum of £500 though larger sums may be considered subject to the discretion of the Trustees and the availability of funds. Applications can be made at any time.

Application Procedure

Applications are to be made by letter or email to the Treasurer and should contain the following information:

- the contact name and contact details of applicant;
- where applicable, what organisation the applicant represents;
- a brief outline of the proposal explaining how this meets our charitable aims and objectives;
- what other sources of funding are being or have been applied for and whether or not these other applications have been successful;
- what sum is being requested;
- the overall budget of the project;
- the timescale of the project including a completion date;
- where applicable, copies of the quotations for the work that is being proposed.

Publications

- Any publications requesting support must be submitted in full as part of the application
- Acknowledgment of financial support must be acknowledged in the publication
- Copies of the publication, if appropriate, must be provided to the UK Legal Deposit Libraries and to Shropshire Archives

Conditions attached to Grants

All grants are to be made subject to the following conditions:

1. acknowledgement of the Society's grant in any publicity or other material relating to the grant;
2. confirmation that the money has been spent as specified in the grant application;
3. a written piece for the Newsletter, Transactions and/or website.
